A Community Recreation Centre

The proposed location, connected to the Arena on the east side, is just blocks from the school and downtown. When complete the facility will be an exciting one-stop recreation and fitness centre – and a perfect fit for Vanderhoof and District residents.

- It includes second floor multipurpose space
- Fitness and multipurpose rooms overlooking the pools is a future expansion
- Connections to the Arena take advantage of staff and energy

The Community Aquatic Centre

The aquatic centre is designed to meet the needs of residents for the next 50 plus years, and includes the following features:

- A six lane, 25 meter lap pool, with a depths of 1 meter to 2.1 meters, just right for swimming lessons, recreation swimming, and fitness classes
- A warm water leisure pool with features enjoyed by young and old, including a ramp and stairs, water sprays, a tot slide, and a lazy river, real fun and therapeutic benefits
- A whirlpool with a capacity of 20 people
- Universal dressing rooms with ease of access for all including families, male and female
- A tiled pool deck, designed for ease of circulation, as well as for socialization and instruction
- Glazing, which provides views into the pool, and out to the mountains
