



**DISTRICT OF VANDERHOOF
BYLAW 1114, 2012**

A bylaw to amend the Corporation of the Village of Vanderhoof Water Connection Rates and Supply Regulation Bylaw No. 125, 1953 as amended by Bylaws No. 720, No. 883, No. 904, No. 914, No. 927, No. 947, No.969 and No. 1032 .

The Council of the District of Vanderhoof in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. User Charges

That Section 3 of Bylaw No. 125, as amended by Bylaw No. 1032 is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefore:

The owner of each and every parcel of real property upon which there is now or hereafter may be situated one or more of the establishments described in the following, shall in respect of each establishment pay or cause to be paid to the District for the use of water supplied by the District to or for such establishment or establishments the following sum or sums:

| Each bowling alley, pool hall, barber shop, or beauty parlor. | |

ANY PREMISES HOUSING A MULTIPLE USE, EXCEPT AS OUTLINED IN (g) ABOVE SHALL BE CHARGED FOR EACH USE.

2. Discount

An early payment discount of 10% will be allowed on payments received prior to the close of business on October 31st of each year.

3. Bulk Water

The charge for the supply of bulk water shall be \$0.01 per gallon plus the cost of any labour to provide the water.

4. Effective Date

This bylaw shall take effect January 1, 2012.

5. Repeal

The District of Vanderhoof Water Rates Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 1032, 2008 is hereby repealed.

6. Citation

This bylaw may be cited as the District of Vanderhoof Water Rates Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 1114, 2012.
