



District of Vanderhoof Bylaw No. 1186, 2018

A bylaw to provide for the determination of various procedures for the conduct of local government elections and assent voting.

WHEREAS under the *Local Government Act*, Council may, by bylaw, determine various procedures and requirements to be applied to the conduct of local government elections and assent voting;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to establish voting procedures and requirements under that authority;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Vanderhoof, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. CITATION

- 1.1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the District of Vanderhoof's "Election and Assent Voting Bylaw No. 1186, 2018".

2. ELECTOR REGISTRATION

- 2.1. As authorized under section 69 of the Local Government Act, for all elections and assent voting, a person may register as an elector only at the time of voting.

3. ADVANCE VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

- 3.1. In addition to the required advance voting opportunity on Wednesday October 10, 2018, the following day(s) are hereby established as advance voting opportunities for the 2018 general local election and other voting:

Thursday October 11, 2018

- 3.2. Additional advance voting opportunities on the dates specified in subsection 2.1 shall be available between the hours of 8:30am to 4:30pm at

Municipal Office, 160 Connaught Street, Vanderhoof

4. SPECIAL VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

- 4.1. To give electors who may otherwise be unable to vote an opportunity to do so, the Council will provide a special voting opportunity as authorized under section 109 of the Local Government Act by establishing the follow places as special voting places on October 11, 2018 for the general local election and assent voting during the hours specified and for the electors specified:

Only electors who are patients or workers at this location may vote at this special voting opportunity

- II. Stuart Nechako Manor

Vanderhoof, BC V0J 3A0
10:00am to 10:30am

Only electors who are residents or workers of this location may vote at this special voting opportunity.

- III. Riverside Lodge
242 Louvain Street
Vanderhoof, BC V0J 3A0
10:45am to 11:15am

- 4.2. The number of candidate representatives who may be present at a special voting opportunity is limited to one (1).

5. RESOLUTION OF TIE AFTER JUDICIAL RECOUNT

- 5.1. In the event of a tie vote after a judicial recount, the tie vote will be resolved by conduction a lot in accordance with section 151 of the *Local Government Act*.

6. REPEAL

- 6.1. This bylaw repeals the District of Vanderhoof's Bylaw No. 921, 2002, Bylaw No. 1134, 2014 and Bylaw No. 1136, 2014 in their entirety.
